Health and safety services of a governmental nature, including, for example: low-income housing (as defined by Federal, State or local law or regulation), alcohol and drug treatment centers, residences and other facilities offering programs for battered spouses, animal control facilities directly related to public health and safety, facilities offering food programs for the needy, daycare centers for children, and daycare centers for individuals with special needs (e.g., those with Alzheimer's disease, autism, muscular dystrophy, etc.).

Ineligible PNPs:

Recreation facilities,

Job counseling and training centers,

Facilities for advocacy groups not directly providing health services

Housing (other than low-income)

Cemeteries

Parking garages

Conference facilities

Facilities maintained by property owners' associations such as roads and recreational facilities (except those facilities that could be classified as utilities or emergency facilities)

Daycare centers for purposes other than those described above
